



Extension Questions

Personal DEA numbers are assigned to individuals and can only be used by the individual it was assigned to. Institutional DEA numbers are assigned to an institution and therefore may be used by multiple individuals. Therefore, an individual using an institutional DEA number will be assigned a unique institutional DEA registration number suffix which is added on to the end of the institutional DEA number.

How would the addition of a suffix affect DEA number validation?

(SAMPLE ANSWER BELOW)

The addition of a suffix means that not only must the DEA number be validated, but the suffix would need to be validated as well.
